Place in Time - April Cut-Aparts (#4500598) (2 sheets per student)
 Place in Time April Foundation (#4500597)
 Place in Time - Sentiments (#4500616)
 Place in Time - Cardstock Alphabet Stickers (#4500618)
 Metal Clothespin Staples (1 per student)
 Dark brown cardstock
 Cream 1/2 inch grosgrain ribbon (approx. 24 inches)
 White acrylic paint
 Brown chalk ink
 Circle Punch (approx. 3/16-inch)
 Postage-edge decorative scissors
 Paper trimmer
 Scissors
 Scoring tool or bone folder
 Tape runner
 Dimensional adhesive
 White glue
 Adhesive dots

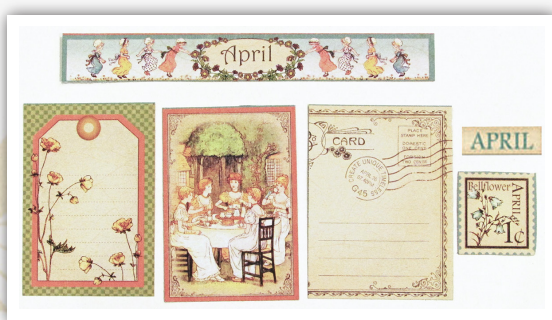
Instructions:

1. Cut dark brown cardstock to 8 1/2 x 5 1/2 inches. Score at 4 1/4 inches to make a standard-sized card.

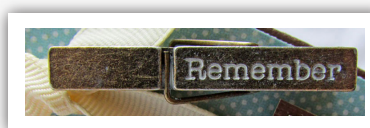


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2. Using the reverse of the Place in Time April Cut-Aparts paper, cut a $3 \frac{1}{4} \times 5 \frac{3}{8}$ inch piece of the green striped pattern. Cut a $1 \times 5 \frac{3}{8}$ inch strip of the blue dot patterned paper. Attach both pieces of patterned paper to the card front. Cover the seam with the cream ribbon. Tie the ribbon in a knot on the left edge of the card. Use an adhesive dot to secure the knot to the card front.



3. From the front of a second sheet of April Cut-Aparts paper, carefully trim out the images shown above. Trim the postcard image in half, reserving the left section for later use. Trim the "April" sentiment from the Sentiments paper. Set all images aside.



4. Rub a bit of white paint onto the Metal Clothespin

Staple. Buff the paint off with a paper towel. Set the clothespin aside to dry.

5. Trim the tag image inside the pink border. Rub the edges of the tag with brown ink, and then tuck the tag under the knot on the ribbon. Rub the edges of the "April" sentiment with brown ink and tuck the sentiment under the ribbon as shown.

6. Trim the "ladies dining" image inside the pink border and rub the edges with brown ink. Mat the image with dark brown cardstock. Using dimensional adhesive, attach the image to the card front. Use a circle



punch to trim the postage cancellation from the postcard

image. Use an adhesive dot to attach the postage circle to the left edge of the "ladies dining" image, tucking the postage cancellation slightly under the main image.

7. Remove the "Memories" sentiment from the Cardstock Alphabet Stickers sheet. Rub the edges of the sentiment with brown ink and mat it with dark brown cardstock. Using dimensional adhesive, attach the sentiment to the bottom left edge of the main image.

8. Using strong glue, attach the metal clothespin to the ribbon knot as shown.



9. Trim a $4 \frac{1}{8} \times 5 \frac{3}{8}$ inch section from the April Foundation

paper. Attach the April strip to the bottom of the Foundation paper and trim to fit. Use postage-edge decorative scissors to trim around the April postage image and attach the image to the upper right corner of the Foundation paper. Attach the Foundation paper to the inside of the card.
