



## "Little Treasure Chest" - ATC Box & Tags


- 1 sheet *Beachcomber* (#4500900)
- 1 sheet *Set Sail* (#4500901)
- 1 sheet *Splash* (#4500902)
- 1 sheet *Pier 45* (#4500904)
- 1 pack Chipboard Tags (#4500910)
- 1 pack Cardstock Stickers (#4500911)
- 4 each Ornate Metal Keys (#4500545)
- 1 each Ornate Metal Keyhole (#4500546)
- 2 each Ornate Metal Door Pulls (#4500548)
- 1 each ATC Book Box (#4500845)

### Additional Supplies & Tools:

1 (4½" x 3¾") piece Core-dinations Bon Voyage blue cardstock, 1 (2½") cut of twill with double red stripe (for box lid), 1 (4") cut of twill with double red stripe, 6 (4") cuts of natural thin twine (for chipboard buttons on top of box), 3 (10") cuts of natural thin twine, 1 (2") cut of natural thin twine, 3 (6") cuts of narrow blue silk ribbon, 1 (10") cut of narrow blue silk ribbon, E6000 glue for metal pieces, Glossy Accents for chipboard, tape runner for all other adhering, Vintage Photo Distress Ink and blending tool or sponge for inking edges, sanding block or file, scissors, foam tape or foam squares.

### Instructions:

1. Ink all edges of book box with distress ink.



2. From the cardstock sticker sheet, cut apart the "Set Sail" sticker shown (at right) The section in the middle will not be used.

3. Cut a 7½" x 8½" piece of *Beachcomber* paper. Score 2½" on all four sides, cut away the corners, and distress ink all edges. Cut 3 sections of the long blue border sticker from the



sticker sheet to adhere across three of the four panels as shown. You'll need to add more from the



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
thin blue sticker from Step 2 to complete the fourth panel. Place tape runner adhesive on the backs of the panels and fit this unit into the book box, pressing well to adhere.



4. Cut a  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{8}$ " piece of Bon Voyage card stock. Sand the outer edges, distress edges carefully with scissors, then adhere to

top of book box. Cut a  $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{8}$ " piece of *Beachcomber* paper, ink edges and adhere to top of book box.

5. From the sheet of *Splash* paper, cut the four  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " wide pieces from the cut-apart side as shown. These will go on the ATC tags. Ink edges and set aside for later.



6. Flip the *Splash* paper over to the back side and cut the following:

- 1 piece  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{4}$ "
- 2 pieces  $3$ " x  $2\frac{1}{8}$ "
- 2 pieces  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{8}$ "

Ink all pieces with Vintage Photo.

7. Adhere the largest piece from Step 6 ( $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{4}$ "") to back of book



box when closed. Adhere two side pieces ( $3$ " x  $2\frac{1}{8}$ ""). Adhere one  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{8}$ " piece to front of box. Save the last  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{8}$ " piece for later.

8. Cut a  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $12$ " strip from *Pier 45* paper, another piece at  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ", then a small piece from *Beachcomber* at  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ". Ink each of these pieces' edges with Vintage Photo.



9. Adhere the *Pier 45* 12" strip around the box starting and ending at the back of the open box, then adhere the final piece from Step 7 ( $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{8}$ "") onto this back panel. Cut another piece from *Pier 45* paper (anchors) at  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{3}{8}$ ", ink the edges, adhere to center panel of box flap. Finally cut a piece of *Beachcomber* paper at  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ ", ink edges. Set aside a moment. Fold a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " length of twill ribbon in half, apply adhesive to hold ends together then adhere to inner portion of box lid, centered, then adhere *Beachcomber* paper onto the panel to cover the raw edges of the ribbon. This ribbon now serves as a pull-point to open the book box. To distress, rub Vintage Photo ink onto both sides of ribbon. Cut a



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4½" length from the octopus border sticker, sand edges lightly then ink with Vintage Photo and adhere across top of inner box lid. (Not shown in this photo. Shown on last page in the final photo)



10. Sand edges of the two end pieces from the "Set Sail" sticker Step 2 then ink edges. Stick onto the box top spread apart as shown.

11. From the Chipboard

sheet pop out the large plaid circular piece, putting aside the center portion, then ink edges. Cut a piece of Splash paper 2½" x 2½" inches and adhere to back of chipboard piece as shown.



12. Adhere the chipboard unit to box's top with Glossy Accents.

13. Adhere two small foam squares on each side of the back of the ornate metal keyhole

as shown. Peel film off and put a dot of E6000 glue on the top and bottom tips of the back of the keyhole for added strength.



14. Adhere keyhole to top of box as shown. Sand the edges of the two blue ticket stickers and ink edges then adhere to lower right of keyhole. Cut a ½" x 1¼" strip of cream paper stamped, written or typed with the word Treasures. Cut a V-notch on the right end, ink edges, curl the paper slightly with a pencil, then adhere to



tickets as shown. Add a small, inked chipboard circle to the right of tickets. Pop out the three chipboard buttons, ink edges, and insert two pieces of 4" long twine in

each and tie knots to secure. Fray ends of each strand. Adhere buttons to box top in upper left corner using Glossy Accents and foam squares for varied levels of dimension. Finish the lid by sanding the edges of the two orange photo corner stickers, ink edges and adhere to box top in lower left and upper right corners.

15. Pop out the striped chipboard tag, ink edges, then tie a small ornate metal key with a 10" length of twine to the tag, a make a bow. Adhere this unit to box's front, centered, using Glossy Accents.



16. Sand edges of two blue photo corner stickers then ink edges and adhere to the two front corners of box base.



Insert two brads into each of the ornate metal door pulls and fold brad prongs flat to secure. Then use E6000 to adhere door pull to box's sides. (Tip box sideways and let one dry completely before adhering the second one.)




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17. For the back of the three ATC Kraft Tags cut three 2½" x 2¼" pieces from *Set Sail* paper. Ink edges. Cut six 2½" x ¼" pieces of *Set Sail* (striped side), two for each tag. Ink edges. Adhere the pieces to the back of each tag as shown.



18. Gather the pieces you cut earlier as shown in photo. Ink all edges.



20. For Tag 2, adhere paper as shown, then the inked chipboard tag and circle to the bottom. Ink the small seahorse chipboard tag and layer a large key over it, then loop a 10" piece of blue silk ribbon and 10" piece of twine through the tag top, catching the key and



19. For the first tag, adhere the paper pieces then adhere inked chipboard tag and circle using Glossy Accents. Tie a 2" length of twine to large key and adhere to chipboard tag. Insert three 6" cuts of silk blue ribbons to tag top. Ink edges of kraft tag, front and back.

tag, then tie into a bow together at the top. Ink edges of tag's front and back.



21. For Tag 3, adhere papers as shown. Ink edges of the "Make a Splash" chipboard tag and circle and adhere across center of tag. Use E6000 to adhere small key to upper right of tag. Finish tag by cutting a 4" piece of red-striped twill, insert one end into tag hole and fold ribbon in half matching up tails. Tie a 10" length of twine around the twill, knot it and then tie a bow. Snip a V-cut into both ends of twill ribbon and rub ink on ribbon to distress. Ink edges of tag's front and back.

22. Congratulations! Just place the tags in the box and you have finished your project!
