

# MOTHER GOOSE TAG ALBUM

Supply List: Graphic 45 Mother Goose collection (12x12, 8x8 and 6x6 paper pads), Graphic 45 Mother Goose chipboards, Graphic 45 Mother Goose banners, Graphic 45 Mother Goose flowers, Graphic 45 Mother Goose large Kraft tags, Graphic 45 Mother Goose small kraft tags, Black ink, Acrylic paints, Paper twine, Sizzix Bigz Tim Holtz Tattered floral die, EK success border punch, Couture Creations Nesting dies: Victorian square



Step 1: Choose papers to use for covering the tags



Step 2: Carefully trace around the tags and cut.



Step 3: Paint the top edge of the tag using different colors of acrylic paint. I used red, orange, yellow, green and blue.



Step 4: Adhere patterned papers to the tags (both sides). Ink the edges with black ink.



Step 5: Trace and cut patterned papers to cover the smaller tags and ink the edges as well.



Step 6: Prepare embellishments (cardstocks, chipboards, stickers, handmade flowers etc). Ink the edges too.



Step 7: Start decorating/embellishing. Start with the cover first. Use a decorative frame die to cut a piece of patterned paper to mat the title work.



Step 8: Use paper twine to hand the embellished small tags. Do this to each tag.



Step 9: Decorate your tags with the prepared embellishments.

Step 10: Secure tags with the provided metal ring.
