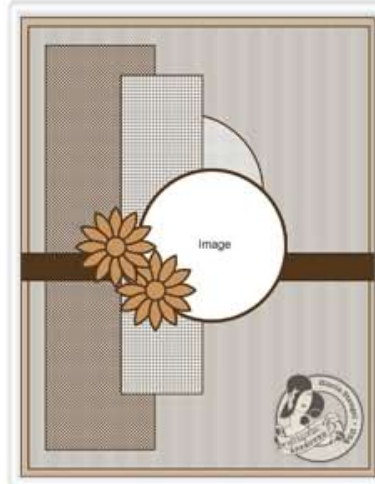
Product and Supplies List:

Graphic 45 Papers:
 Place in Time: February Cut-Aparts
 Bird Song Harmony
 Cardstock: Bazzill Cajun, Butter Cream
 Ink: Memento Tuxedo Black
 Stamps: My Favorite Things
 Die cuts: Spellbinders Heart Circles,
 Standard Circles Large, Standard Circles
 Small
 Ribbon and Twine: Really Reasonable
 Ribbon
 Flowers: Wild Orchid Crafts
 Adhesive: Scotch tape runner (ATG);
 Scrapbook Adhesives by 3L foam squares;
 Aleene's Tacky Glue; Beacon Fabri-tac
 Tools: Grand Calibur (Spellbinders); Bow
 Easy
 Tools: Foam brush (Michael's Crafts), Grand
 Calibur (Spellbinders), Microtip scissors
 (Fiskars)

Step One: Cut red cardstock to 11 x 4 1/4 inches. Score at 5 1/2 inches to create a top-fold card.

(Designer note: The main reason why I make mostly top-fold cards is that they are easier)

Step Two: Trim the "girl with umbrella" image from the Place in Time February Cut-Aparts paper. Set aside.



Step Three: Trim cream cardstock to slightly smaller than the card front. Then trim Bird Song Harmony paper to slightly smaller than the cream cardstock and glue together. Set aside.

Step Four: Trim cream cardstock to 5 x 2 inches. Trim floral print from the reverse of the Place in Time February Cut-Aparts to slightly smaller and glue together. Attach to the left edge of the panel created in Step 3.

Step Five: Wrap cream ribbon around the panel and secure to the back of the panel created above, in Step 4. Attach panel to the card front. (Note: you are NOT creating the bow yet.)



Step Six: Cut red circle approximately 2 inches around. Trim heart print from the reverse of the Place in Time February Cut-Aparts to slightly smaller and glue together. Attach the circle to the right of the card as shown.

Step Seven: Trim cream cardstock to 4 x 1 1/2 inches. Trim stripped print from the reverse of the Place in Time February Cut-Aparts to slightly smaller and glue together. Attach to the card front, overlapping the floral panel and the heart circle.

Step Eight: Trim another circle from red cardstock, approximately 2 1/2 inches around. You may choose to use a decorative die cut shape to match the sample. Using a slightly smaller circle shape, trim out part of the "girl with umbrella" image from the Place in Time February Cut-Aparts paper. Attach to the red circle, and adhere to the card front with foam dimensional tape.

Step Nine: Using a bow-making tool, such as the Bow Easy, tie a bow from the cream ribbon. Glue to the left edge of the card. Tie another bow from striped baker's twine and glue to the top of the ribbon bow.



Step Ten: Glue assorted flowers to the bows.



Step Eleven: Finish the inside of the card with cream cardstock and a scrap of printed paper. Stamp your greeting in black dye ink.
