Bag Full of Tags

Supplies needed:

- Graphic 45 patterned paper, Chipboard elements and/or Stickers
- Small, handled gift bag (sample measures 5 1/4" w x 3 1/2" d x 8 5/8 h. Adjust dimensions given if using a bag with different dimensions)
- Chipboard
- (2) 1" x 7" pieces of coordinating cardstock
- (6) 5" x 7" card stock tags
- Coordinating card stock for additional tags and photo mattes
- 1/4" hole punch
- Adhesive and glue

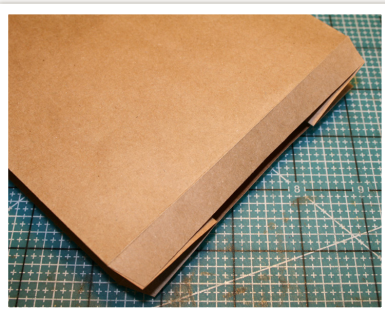
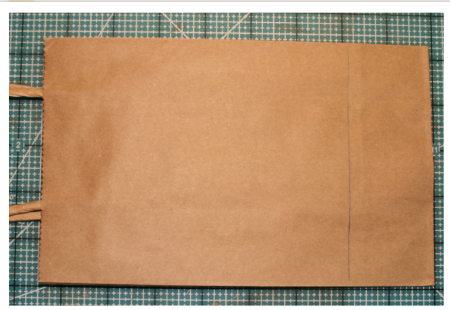
1. Cut Chipboard as follows:

Bottom - 3 1/2" x 5 1/4"

Sides - (2) 3 1/2" x 5 1/4"

Front/Back - (2) 5 1/4" x 5 1/4"

Adjust dimensions for bags with different dimensions.

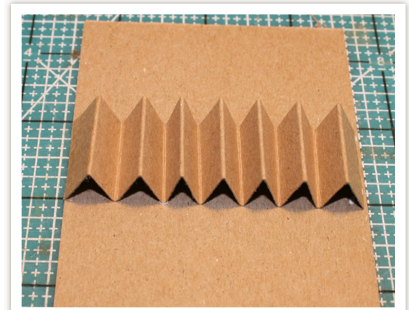


2. Trim gift bag to 6 1/2" from top edge

3. Score and fold 1/2" up from bottom edge. Snip corners to score line.

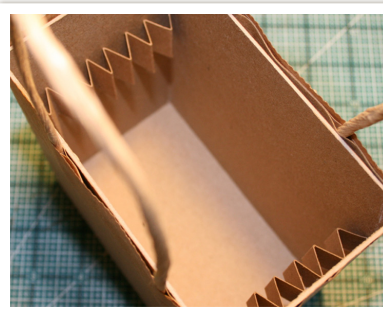
4. Attach tabs of bag to chipboard bottom piece

5. Score 1" x 7" cardstock strips at 1/2" intervals. Fold in an accordion fold. Attach to chipboard sides 1 1/2" below top edge of chip board.

6. Attach chipboard sides and front to inside of bag.



7. Add patterned paper to front, back and sides of bag exterior.



8. Trim corners of tags and punch hole in center top. Slide tags into slots created by accordion folded strips on side of bag.



9. Embellish front of bag with Graphic 45 images

10. Embellish tags with Graphic 45 images and coordinating cardstock tags and photo mattes.



11. Add ribbon to hole in tags.

12. Add photo's and journaling
