Supplies and Tools List:

Place in Time - May Cut-Apart (#4500600) (2 sheets per student) Place in Time - May Foundation (#4500599) Place in Time Sentiments (#4500616) Ornate Metal Keys Staples (#4500545) -1 small key per student

1 sheet (12x12) black cardstock 10" dark purple sheer ribbon 6" purple and blue ombre sheer ribbon White craft ink Postage edge decorative scissors Hole punch Paper trimmer Scissors Scoring tool or bone folder White glue Tape runner Foam adhesive



Instructions:

- 1. Cut black cardstock to 11 x 4 1/4 inches. Score at 5 1/2 inches to make a standardsized top-fold card.
- 2. From the front of the sheet of May Cut-Aparts paper, carefully trim out the images shown above. You will also need "violet and butterflies" chipboard tag from Chipboard Tags 1. Set all images aside.

3. Using the reverse of the Place in Time May Cut-Aparts paper, cut a $31/2 \times 4$ 1/8 inches piece of the purple floral patterned paper. Cut a second piece to 2

x 4 1/8 inches. Attach the purple floral paper to the front of the card, overlapping to make one piece that is 5 3/8 x 4 1/8 inches. Make sure the seam is approximately 2 inches from the bottom of the card.

4. Place the postcard image, trimmed from the Place in Time May Cut-Aparts sheet, in the center of the card front, at an angle.

5. Trim a 1 $1/4 \times 4$ inches piece of purple stripped paper. Mat the purple paper with black cardstock cut to 1 3/8 x 4 1/8 inches. Wrap purple sheer ribbon around



the panel as shown and attach the panel to the card, covering the seam on the purple floral paper.

6. Tie sheer ombre ribbon through a small



Ornate Metal Keys Staples and the hole in the "violet and butterfly" chipboard tag. Glue the tag to the left side of

the card as shown.

7. Attach the "Just for You" sentiment from the Sentiments sheet to the top of the tag as shown. Trim the butterfly postage image with postage-edge decorative scissors and attach as shown.

8. Lightly crumple the edges of the postcard image to add interest and dimension to the card.



9. Trim a 5 3/8 x 4 1/8 inch piece from the May Foundations paper and attach it to the inside of the card. Attach the flower border to the center of the card, making

sure to glue only the left and right edges.

10. Use a hole punch to punch the hole in the floral tag. Tie purple sheer purple ribbon through the hole and slide the tag under the floral border.
