



## Place In Time - November Card "A Grateful Heart"

### Graphic 45® Supplies:

2 sheets November Cut-Apart (#4500612)  
1 sheet Place in Time Sentiments (#4500616)  
1 sheet Place in Time Chipboard Tags 2 (#4500620)  
1 Ornate Metal Label Holder Staples (#4500547)

### Additional Supplies:

1 sheet Core'dinations Venetian Lace Cardstock (cream)  
1 sheet Core'dinations Heritage Kraft Cardstock (kraft)  
1 yard natural jute twine

### Tools:


Paper trimmer, scissors, scoring tool or bone folder, ruler, adhesive dots, tape runner, dimensional foam adhesive, postage edge decorative scissors (optional), brown dye ink (optional), craft hammer

### Instructions:

\* All measurements are length x width.

\*\* Use a sanding block to smooth any rough edges on cardstock punch-outs or chipboard elements.

1. Cut kraft cardstock to 11" x 4 1/4". Score at 5 1/2" to create a top-fold, 5 1/2" x 4 1/4" card.
2. From the reverse of a sheet of *November Cut-Apart* paper, trim the green check paper to 3 1/2" x 4 1/8". Trim a second piece to 2" x 4 1/8". Attach both pieces of the green check paper to the card front, making sure to leave a 1/16" border along the edges. Make sure the paper splice is closer to the top of the card.



## Place In Time - November Card "A Grateful Heart"


3. From a sheet of *November Cut-Apart* paper, carefully trim the "Pilgrim children" image, a postage stamp, a tag image, and the "grateful heart" border. (Use postage-edge decorative scissors to trim the postage image, if desired.)



4. From the *Sentiments* paper, trim out the "Thank You" sentiment.

5. Remove the pumpkin border from the *Chipboard Tags 2* sheet.

6. Attach the chipboard pumpkin border to the top of the card as shown, making sure to cover the area where the green check paper is spliced together.



7. Trim the "Pilgrim children" image and mat with green and kraft cardstock, if desired. Making sure to only place adhesive on three sides, creating a pocket, attach the image to the right edge of the card front, below the pumpkin border.

8. Trim the border from the tag and punch a hole in the center of the tag. Tie a length of jute twine to the tag and place the tag into the pocket.

9. Trim the postage stamp image and attach it at an angle on upper right corner of the main image.


10. Using a craft hammer, gently flatten the handle on the *Ornate Metal Label Holder*.



11. Attach the "Thank You" sentiment to the label holder. Attach the label holder, with the handle pointing up, to the top center of the card using brads.



12. Wrap jute twine around the label holder and tie a "loopy" bow to the center of the label holder handle



13. Cut cream cardstock to 5  $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 4  $\frac{1}{8}$ " and attach to the inside of the card. Trim the "grateful heart" border strip to 4  $\frac{1}{8}$ " and attach it to the bottom of the card.
