Graphic 45® Supplies:

- 2 sheets October Cut-Apart (#4500610)
- 1 sheet October Foundation (#4500609)

Additional Supplies:

- 1 sheet Core'dinations Photogenic cardstock (12x12)
- 1 sheet Core'dinations Bordeaux cardstock (12x12)
- 1 sheet Off-white cardstock (12x12) *Optional
- 1 yard Black silk ribbon (3/4" width)

Tools:

Paper trimmer, scissors, scoring tool or bone folder and scoring board, ruler, adhesive dots, tape runner, 3D foam adhesive.

Instructions:

- *All measurements are length x width.
- **Use a sanding block to smooth rough edges on cardstock punch-outs or chipboard elements.

1. Cut black cardstock to 11" x 4 1/4". Score at 5 1/2" to create a top-fold, 5 1/2" x 4 1/4" card.


2. From a sheet of *October Cut-Apart* paper, carefully trim the images shown.

3. From the reverse of a sheet of *October Cut-Apart* paper, trim purple dot pattern to 3 5/8" x 4 1/8".

4. Wrap a 6" piece of black silk ribbon (1/4" width) around the purple dot paper, approximately 2" from the top. Secure to the back of the dot paper with double-sided tape.




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5. Attach the purple dot paper to the center of the card front as shown.


6. Cut two strips of black cardstock to 2" x 4 1/8". Tear the cardstock as shown. (For best effect, use cardstock with a light core.)

7. Cut two strips of purple cardstock to 2" x 4 1/8 inches. Tear the cardstock, as shown. (For best effect, use cardstock with a light core or ink the edges with contrasting ink.)



8. Layer the torn cardstock onto the card front, placing the purple cardstock on the top, allowing a 1/16" of the card front to show as a border.

9. Trim the Happy Halloween border image into two strips, 4 1/8" long. Attach one strip to the top of the card, 1/16" from the edge of the card. Attach the second strip to the bottom of the card, 1/16" from the card edge.



10. Trim the witch image to remove the orange border. Mat the image with black cardstock, cut slightly larger than the image.

11. Attach the image to the left side of the card using foam adhesive.

12. Create a "loopy" bow from black silk ribbon. To make a loopy bow, wrap the ribbon around your fingers a few times. Slide the ribbon off your fingers and pinch it in the middle. Tie the pinched area with a short length of ribbon. Trim all the ribbon tails.



13. Glue the loopy bow to the right side of the image.

14. Fussy cut the candle image from the tag cut

from a sheet of *October Cut-Apart* paper. Attach the candle image to the center of the bow.

15. Trim *October Foundations* paper (or the cream cardstock) to 5 3/8" x 4 1/8" and attach to the inside of the card.
