Graphic 45[®] Supplies:

- 1 sheet September Cut-Aparts (#4500608)
- 1 sheet September Foundation Page (#4500607)
- 1 sheet Chipboard Tags 2 (#4500620)

Additional Supplies:

- 1 sheet Black Cardstock (12 x 12)
- 1 sheet Tan Cardstock (12 x 12)
- 1 yard Black silk or faux silk ribbon (1/2" width)
- 12 inches Black twine or cord
- 12 inches White twine or string
- 3 Buttons (red, yellow, tan)
- 1 Black mini brad

Tools:

Paper trimmer, Scissors, Scoring tool or Bone folder and scoring board, Ruler, White glue or Adhesive dots, Tape runner, 3D Foam adhesive, Postage edge decorative scissors (optional)

Instructions:


- *All measurements are length x width.
- * * Use a sanding block to smooth any rough edges on cardstock punch-outs or chipboard elements.
- 1. Cut black cardstock to 8 $^{1}/_{2}$ " x 5 $^{1}/_{2}$ ". Score at 4 1/4" to create a card.
- 2. From the front of a sheet of September Cut-Aparts paper, trim the images shown. Use postage-edge decorative scissors to trim out the postage images, if desired. Select the silhouette image from the Chipboard Tags 2 set.
- 3. Cut September Foundations paper to 4 1/8" x 5 3/8". Attach to the black cardstock.

4. Trim the yellow floral print from the September Cut-Aparts paper to 3/4" x 5 3/8". Attach it to the center of the card.



- 5. Trim out the math problems strip from September Cut-Aparts paper and attach it to the center of the yellow print as shown.
- 6. From the reverse of the September Cut-Aparts paper, trim six (6) squares, 1 ½" each, from the black text print. Attach each square to the card front in a grid pattern as shown.
- 7. Trim the "girls at play" silhouette image from the September Cut-Aparts paper slightly smaller than 1 1/2". Attach the image to the first black text square.



- 8. Trim out two postage stamp images from the September Cut-Aparts paper and attach them to the second and fourth squares with dimensional adhesive as shown.
- 9. Tie a length of cream twine trough the holes of three small buttons and attach the buttons to the third square.

10. Place a black mini brad into the hole of the chipboard tag. Attach the tag to the card, overlapping the fifth and sixth squares.



11. Tie a bow with black ribbon and attach to the right hand side of the chipboard tag.



- 12. Cut September Foundations paper to 4 1/8" \times 5 % and attach to the inside of the card.
- 13. Trim yellow floral print from the September Cut-Aparts paper to 1 1/2" x 5 3/8". Place adhesive on the bottom and sides of the paper and attach it to the card to form a pocket.
- 14. Trim out the ruler strip from *September* Cut-Aparts paper and attach it to the center of the yellow print as shown.
- 15. Trim the "school days" sentiment from the tag on the September Cut-Aparts paper and attach it to the ruler with dimensional adhesive.
- 16. Trim several tags from the September Cut-Aparts. Punch a hole in each tag and tie a length of ribbon or twine through each hole. Place the tags into the pocket.
