Additional Supplies & Tools:

1 sheet black cardstock (12x12), 1 sheet black chipboard (12x12), 2 paper doilies (4" diameter), 84" black satin ribbon (5/8" wide), 64" black twine, 30" black/orange check sheer ribbon (1 1/2"), 1 mini brad, 1 black eyelet, black dye ink, black spray mist, paper trimmer, scissors, bone folder or scoring board and tool, ruler, corner rounder, sanding block, hole-punches (5/8", 1/8" & 1/16"), acrylic stamping blocks, craft knife, glue, adhesive dots, tape runner and dimensional foam adhesive


*Measurements are length x width.

*Use a sanding block to smooth rough edges on cardstock punch-outs or chipboard elements.



1. First, we will make the book binding. Cut two pieces of black cardstock as follows: cut one piece to 5" x 12" and one piece to 5" x 3". Splice the cardstock together to make a strip 5" by 13½".



2. Score the black cardstock strip on the long side at 1", 1¾", 2½", 3", 3¾", 4½", 5", 5¾", 6½", 7", 7¾", 8½", 9", 9¾", 10½", 11", 11¾" and 12½".





3. Fold the cardstock strip using an accordion fold.



4. Flip the pleated cardstock over and place adhesive on every other ¾" section as shown.

5. Press the ¾-inch sections together to form six tabs as shown. There should be a 1" section to the left and to the right of the tabs. Set aside.




6. Cut two pieces of black chipboard to 7" x 4½" for your book covers. Cut one piece of black chipboard to 7" x 3" to reinforce the spine.

7. Cut *Witching Hour* paper to 7" x 3" and attach to one side of the chipboard piece of the same size. Set aside.

8. Attach the left, 1" tab of the cardstock spine onto one of the 7" x 4½" chipboard covers.

Make sure the cardstock spine is centered on the chipboard as shown.



9. Attach the right "tab" of the cardstock spine onto the other 7" x 4 1/2" chipboard cover. The covers should be approximately 3" apart with the spine tabs between them.



10. Cut two pieces of *Witching Hour* paper to 7" x 4 1/2" and place on the inside of the chipboard pieces.



11. Flip the book over and place adhesive on the back of the spine as shown.

12. Attach the chipboard spine over the adhesive, making sure the printed paper is on the inside of the book as shown.



13. Cut *Beware* paper to 7" x 9". Center the paper over the spine and wrap it around the outside of the book as shown. There will be 1 1/2" of chipboard showing on the front and back covers.

14. Cut two pieces of *Fanciful Floral* paper to 7" x 4". Attach to the front and back covers, making sure to line up the paper with the edges of the chipboard.

15. Cut two pieces of black cardstock to 7" x 1". Attach one to the front of the book and one to the back, approximately $\frac{3}{8}$ " from edge of the spine.



16. Trim $\frac{1}{2}$ " from the bottom of two Graphic 45® Regular Tag Staples.



17. Trim two pieces of *Beware* cardstock to 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ ". Use a corner rounder, or use the rounded tag corners as a guide, to trim the paper. Attach the paper to the top of the tag, matching up the corners.



18. Attach one tag horizontally onto the inside front cover. Make sure that the rounded part of the tag and the hole hang off the edge of the cover. Repeat for the back cover. (Later in the workshop, ribbon will be threaded through the holes in the tags to act as a closure for the book.)



19. Set the book aside while we work on the tags. We will add the tags and finish decorating the book later.

Tag #1 - "Madame Macabre!"

Instructions:

1. Spray a 4" doily with black glimmer mist and set it aside to dry.



2. Cut *Fanciful Floral* paper to 6" x 4". Use a pencil to trace the tag onto the back side of the paper. Mark the location of the hole and use a $\frac{5}{8}$ " hole punch to punch out the hole.



4. Use a sanding block to smooth out any rough edges. If desired, edge with black ink.

3. Attach the paper to the tag, trim the corners and sides with scissors.



5. To decorate your tag, you need the five items shown.



6. Attach the doily to the center of the tag. Allow the doily to hang off the right edge of the tag about $\frac{1}{2}$ ".



7. Trim the Spell Cards image cut from *Nevermore* paper, distress edges. Lightly crumple the image, and then attach it to the left edge of the tag, at a slight angle as shown (next page)

8. Trim the "Madame Macabre" image cut from *Frightful Folly* paper as shown. Distress the edges with your scissors. Lightly crumple the image, and then attach it to the tag with dimensional adhesive. Roll the corners.



9. Trim out the "Madame Macabre" label and attach it with 3D foam adhesive.

10. Fold the "Potions and Charms" envelop from *Cardstock Tags and Pockets* and attach it to the upper right corner.



11. Attach the "Dr. Dreadful" sticker from *Cardstock Stickers* to a bit of scrap paper, chipboard, or dimensional adhesive. Use a $\frac{1}{16}$ " hole punch or a piercing tool to poke a hole in the upper left corner of the sticker.

12. Use black twine to tie the sticker, the chipboard tag from *Chipboard Tags 2*, and a metal key together.

13. Glue the sticker, tag, and key to the upper left corner of the tag.



14. Tie a length of black, satin ribbon through the hole at the top of the kraft tag.

Tag #2 - "So Curious" (pocket tag)

1. Cut *Clockworks* paper to 6" x 4". Use a pencil to trace the tag onto the back side of the paper. Mark the location of the hole. Use a $\frac{5}{8}$ " hole punch to punch out the hole.




2. Attach the paper to the tag. Trim around the tag with scissors



or a craft knife. Use a sanding block to smooth out any rough edges. If desired, edge with black ink.

3. Trim the *Witching Hour* paper to 3" x 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ ". Place adhesive on the back as shown. Place adhesive on the right, bottom, and the lower half of the left side.



4. Attach the *Witching Hour* paper to the tag, about 1" from the bottom. You have now created a pocket. Roll the right edge down for extra dimension and interest.


5. To decorate your tag, you will need the items shown.



6. Attach the clock sticker from *Cardstock Stickers* to the upper right corner of the tag using dimensional adhesive.

7. Place the tag from the *Cardstock Tags and Pockets* into the pocket you created.

8. Trim "So Very Curious" journaling tag cut from *Frightful Folly* to size and attach to the left side of the tag as shown, using

dimensional adhesive. Roll the corners.



9. Attach the spider banner from *Cardstock Banners* onto the "So Very Curious" image, overlapping the spider printed on the journaling tag.

10. Attach the skull banner from *Cardstock Banners* to the tag with dimensional adhesive.

11. Create a knot with black twine and glue it to the images as shown, creating a "mini" banner.



12. Using a stylus and your fingers, gently roll and crumple the petals of 5 flowers from the *Cardstock Flowers* and glue together.



13. Attach the gear to the flower center with dimensional adhesive. Attach the flower to the lower right corner of the "So Very Curious" image.

14. Attach the Steampunk banner flag to the right edge of the tag. Make sure to tuck the banner under the petals of the flower.



15. Tie a length of sheer black and orange check ribbon through the hole at the top of the kraft tag.

Tag #3 - "Dr. Dreadful" (pocket tag)

1. Cut the *Frightful Folly* (reverse) paper to 6" x 4". Use a pencil to trace the tag onto the back side of the paper. Mark the location of the hole. Use a $\frac{5}{8}$ " hole punch to punch out the hole.



2. Attach the paper to the tag. Trim around the tag with scissors or a craft knife. Use a sanding block to smooth out any rough edges. If desired, edge with black ink.

3. To decorate your tag, collect the items shown.




4. Trim *Pumpkin Power* paper to 4" x 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ ". Trim *Totally Wicked* paper to 2" x 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ ".



5. Attach the *Totally Wicked* Paper to the top of the REVERSE side of the *Pumpkin Power* paper, as shown (below). Line up all edges.



6. Flip the paper over so that the *Pumpkin Power* side is face up. Fold the upper left corner back, revealing



the *Totally Wicked* print.

7. Attach adhesive to three sides of the back of the panel as shown (next page), to form a pocket.





8. Attach the pocket to the tag, approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ " from the bottom of the tag. Apply the "Witching Hour" sticker from *Cardstock Stickers* across the bottom of the pocket.

9. Place the owl tag from *Cardstock Tags and Pockets* into the pocket you created.

10. Attach the "Spooky" tag from *Chipboard Tags 2* to the upper left corner of the tag. Glue a small gear punch-out from *Cardstock Flowers* to cover the hole in the chipboard tag.



11. Using dimensional adhesive, attach the clock punch-out from *Cardstock Banners* to the left edge of the tag, tucking it slightly into the pocket.




12. With a $\frac{1}{16}$ " hole punch or a paper piercing tool, punch a hole in the folded flap of the pocket as shown.


13. Attach the Ornate Metal Keyhole Staple

to the pocket flap using a mini brad. You may use glue or an adhesive dot to make sure it is secure.

14. Using black twine, tie the chipboard flag to the bottom hole in the keyhole. You may secure the chipboard flag with dimensional adhesive.



15. Using sharp scissors, fussy cut the "Dr. Dreadful" image and label from *Frightful Folly* paper. Attach to the tag as shown with dimensional adhesive.



16. Attach the floral banner from *Cardstock Tags and Pockets* to the upper right of the tag.



17. Using some black twine, tie the balloon chipboard through the hole in the kraft tag.

18. Tie a length of black, satin ribbon through the hole at the top of the kraft tag.

Tag #4 - "Miss Ima Fraid"

1. Spray a 4" doily with black glimmer mist and set it aside to dry. (You may have completed this step at the beginning of the workshop.)




2. Cut *Fanciful Floral* (reverse) paper to 6" x 4". Use a pencil to trace the tag onto the back side of the paper. Mark the location of the hole. Use a 5/8" hole punch to punch out the hole.

3. Attach the paper to the tag. Trim around the tag with scissors or a craft knife.

4. Use a sanding block to smooth out any rough edges. If desired, edge with black ink.



5. To decorate your tag, you need the items shown.



6. Attach the doily to the center of the tag.


7. Attach the tab from the *Chipboard Tags 2* to the top of the tag as shown.

8. Trim the "Miss Ima Fraid" image cut from *Frightful Folly* paper as shown. Distress

the edges with your scissors. Lightly crumple the image, and then attach it to the tag with dimensional adhesive. Roll the corners.

9. Trim out the "Miss Ima Fraid" label and attach it with foam adhesive.

10. Attach gear punch-outs from the *Cardstock Banners* to the left and right edges of the "Miss Ima Fraid" image.

14. Attach the button sticker from *Cardstock Stickers* to a bit of scrap paper, chipboard, or



11. Attach the black flags from the *Cardstock Banner* to the bottom edge of the tag, approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ " from the bottom of the tag.

dimensional adhesive. Use black twine to tie a bow to the button. Attach the button to the left edge of the "Miss Ima Fraid" image.

15. Tie a length of black, satin ribbon through the hole at the top of the kraft tag.



12. Using dimensional adhesive, attach the "Love Potion" punch-outs from the *Cardstock Banners* to the flags, as shown.

13. Tie two lengths of black twine into bows and glue to the ends of the flag banner.




Tag #5 - "Love Potion No. 45" (pocket)

1. Cut *Beware* (reverse) paper to 6" x 4" inches. Use a pencil to trace the tag onto the back side of the paper. Mark the location of the hole. Use a 5/8" hole punch to punch out the hole.




2. Attach the paper to the tag. Trim around the tag with scissors or a craft knife. Use a sanding block to smooth out any rough edges. If desired, edge with black ink.



3. To decorate the tag, you need the items shown.



4. Trim *Mechanical Marvels* paper to 2 1/2" x 3 7/8". Round the bottom corners. Place adhesive on the back as shown to form a pocket.



5. Attach the *Mechanical Marvels* paper to the tag, lining up the bottom corners. You have now created a pocket.

6. Place the scalloped flowers border from the *Cardstock Stickers* onto the *Mechanical Marvels* paper to decorate the top of the pocket.

7. Place the Steampunk and Love Potion tags from the *Cardstock Tags and Pockets* into the pocket.




8. Use sharp scissors to fussy cut the images shown. Edge the images with black ink, if desired. Place the altered images into the pocket you created.



9. Using a stylus and your fingers, gently roll and crumple the petals of three *Cardstock Flowers*. Glue the flowers together.

10. Attach the punch-out flower to the center of the blue flower using dimensional adhesive. Attach the flower to the right edge of the pocket.

11. Place the "Love Potion" sticker from the *Cardstock Stickers* to the left of the flower.



12. Attach the Steampunk October gear from the *Cardstock Banner* to the upper left of the flower. Make sure to tuck the gear under the petals of the flower.

13. Tie a length of sheer black and orange check ribbon through the hole at the top of the kraft tag.

Tag #6 - "Mr. Seymour Bones"


1. Cut *Totally Wicked* (reverse) paper to 6" x 4". Use a pencil to trace the tag onto the back side of the paper. Mark the location of the hole. Use a $\frac{5}{8}$ " hole punch to punch out the hole.



2. Attach the paper to the tag. Trim around the tag with scissors or a craft knife. Use a sanding block to smooth out any rough edges. If desired, edge with black ink.



3. To decorate your tag, you need the items shown.



4. Fussy cut the "Beware!" image from *Frightful Folly* paper and attach it to the upper left of the tag.

5. Trim the "Mr. Seymour Bones" image cut from *Frightful Folly* paper as shown. Distress the edges with your scissors. Lightly crumple the

image, and then attach it to the tag with dimensional adhesive. Roll the corners.

6. Using sharp scissors, cut a slit between each petal of the three flowers from *Cardstock Flowers*.

7. Gently crumple each flower, then unfold and glue the layers together.

8. Attach the punch-out gear to the center of the blue flower using foam dimensional adhesive.

Shape the flowers with your fingers. Attach the flower to the lower left corner of the tag.



9. Attach the "Spooky" sticker tag to the upper right of the kraft tag.

10. Attach the "Tick-Tock" tag from *Cardstock Tags and Pockets* to the left of the "Mr. Seymour Bones" image.


11. Attach four gear punch-outs from the *Cardstock Banners* to the top, left, and right edges of the "Mr. Seymour Bones" image.

12. Attach the "Double, double" sticker to the lower left corner of the "Mr. Seymour Bones" image, tucking the edge under the flower.

13. Trim out the "Mr. Seymour Bones" label and attach it with dimensional adhesive.

14. Attach the skull banner from *Cardstock Banners* to the lower left of the tag, tucking it under the flower.

15. Tie a length of black satin ribbon through the hole at the top of the kraft tag.




*Next, attach the tags to complete your Book of Spells!

1. Open your book so that the spine tabs are face up. Collect all six of your tags.



2. Place a strip of adhesive on the back of each tag, as close to the right edge as possible.

3. Attach each tag to the front or the binding tabs as shown in the photo.



4. There are six binding tabs; one for each tag. Make sure to line up the edges of the tag with the spine.



5. To decorate the book, you need these items.



6. Fold a pocket from *Cardstock Tags and Pockets*, and insert a tag. Attach to the inside right cover of the book.

7. Attach the butterfly frame from *Chipboard Tags 2* to the inside back cover.



8. Using a stylus and your fingers, gently roll and crumple the petals of three *Cardstock Flowers*. Glue the flowers together.

Fussy cut around the clock punch-out from *Cardstock Banners*. Attach to the center of the flower with dimensional adhesive.



9. Glue the flower to the left side of the cover as shown.

10. Glue small gear punch-outs from *Cardstock Flowers* to the "Curious" chipboard tag from *Chipboard Tags 2*. Attach the chipboard tag to the right of the flower.

11. Decorate the spine of the book with stickers from *Cardstock Stickers*.



12. Punch a hole in the top center of the spine and reinforce with a black eyelet. Thread black twine or cord through the hole. Dangle a chipboard tag from *Chipboard Tags 2* and a metal key from the twine.

13. Place a length of black satin ribbon through the holes in the horizontal tags, which are attached to the covers. Tie a bow to act as the book closure.
