• Supplies

- A Ladies' Diary "Moment in Time"
- A Ladies' Diary "Garden Stroll"
- A Ladies' Diary "Delicate Details"
- Graphic 45 - Metal Key Staples
- Misc - Ivory or White Cardstock
- Misc - Ivory Lace
- Misc - Ivory Ribbon (May Arts 1" wide seam binding)
- Misc - Self Adhesive Pearls (Small and Medium)
- Misc - Foam Mounting Tape (Optional)
- Misc - Distress Ink (Optional)

INSTRUCTIONS

Many of the decorative elements on this card can either be adhered flat or with foam mounting tape for dimension. If adhering these pieces with foam mounting tape, adhere a piece of scrap cardboard to the back first to strengthen the paper (this is a great use for you paper pad covers).

Cut a piece of ivory or white cardstock 3" wide x 6" high and cut the two top corners off at an angle to form a tag shape.

Cut a piece of from the Moment in Time paper to cover the tag and trim the edges. Cut a piece of lace to fit the bottom of the tag and adhere to the bottom of the tag on the back. From the Garden Stroll paper cut a piece 2 1/2" wide x 4 1/2" high and adhere to the tag either with regular adhesive or foam mounting tape for dimension. Cut a clock face from the Moment in Time paper and adhere to the top of the Garden Stroll paper. Cut a piece of Garden Stroll paper (from the side with the Ladies showing) 2 3/4" wide x 3 1/2" high and adhere it to the center of the tag with adhesive or foam mounting tape.

Cut a set of two flowers from the Delicate Details paper and then one smaller flower. Layer the smaller flower on top of the larger of the two previous flowers to create dimension. Adhere a pearl into the center of the two flowers. Adhere the flowers to the bottom right corner of the tag. Using a strong-hold adhesive adhere the key to the front of the tag as shown. Adhere a small self adhesive pearl to the decorative part at the top of the key. Punch a hole in the top of the tag. The ribbon may be threaded through the hole and tied into a bow or alternatively, tie a bow and adhere it to the top of the tag with a strong-hold adhesive.
